EWB International has successfully accomplished another year of challenges!

We have strengthened our good cooperation with the international partners and implemented for us few very important educational capacity grants: (a) The final event of 200,000 USD ALCOA Foundation grant - the Global Engineer International Forum - took place in Denver, USA on 17th March 2016; (b) Six EWB member associations implemented within the Tetra Tech's 50th Anniversary Global Clean Water Fund, the 50,000 USD grant program that supported selected projects providing clean water for communities in need; (c) Arconic Foundation announced provision of a 130,000 USD grant to EWB-I that will facilitate the development of innovative educational practices around the world.

The new EWB-I website is active and serve as open window to the world and our members. The EWB-I quarterly Newsletter is back! With the extensive support of the experienced team of EWB Argentina, 3 new issues of the Newsletter have been prepared. The President of EWB-I was a member of the international jury for the Siemens Stiftung empowering people. Award!. The Award ceremony took place in Berlin in October 2016. It was excellent opportunity to meet the innovators in person and also to promote EWB-I as one of the key global networks increasing the quality of life for the poor communities in developing countries. EWB-I has started the election process for the Executive Committee and 9 candidates have been nominated. The voting will start in January 2017 and by March 2017 the results will be announced.

Starting from May 2016, Ms. Lionelle Samnick has been contracted as EWB-I Secretary and she is in charge of providing technical assistance to the EWB-I Board.
